

Summary of Requirements for the Sociology Minor

1. A minimum of 24 credits (typically 6 courses) in undergraduate sociology courses. These credits must be taken for letter grades with a grade of C- or better to count toward the minor.
2. At least 12 of the 24 credits must be upper division; at least 12 of the credits must be taken at the University of Oregon, and 8 of the credits taken at the UO must be upper division.
3. No more than 4 credits in courses numbered 401-406 may be applied to the minor. These may be taken pass/no pass (P/N); P grades must be earned to apply them to the minor.
4. Completion of *ONE* of the following four-credit courses:
 - SOC 310 Development of Sociology
 - SOC 311 Introduction to Social Research
 - SOC 312 Quantitative Methods in Sociology
5. Prerequisites: SOC 204 or 207 is required as a prerequisite for some upper division courses; MATH 95 or an equivalent is recommended prior to SOC 312; SOC 310, 311 and 312 are prerequisites for some 400-level lecture courses. Minor students may ask 400-level instructors for a prerequisite waiver, to be given at the instructor's discretion.
6. SOC 312 can alternatively be fulfilled by successfully completing MATH 243, 425, 426, 461 or PSY302 with a grade of C- or better. MATH 243 will not count as upper division credit.
7. Up to 8 credits (2 courses) may overlap with the requirements of a major. If you are concerned about overlap, speak with your major advisor or the sociology advisor.
