DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

Major Requirements — Effective Fall 2021

The Department of History offers a Bachelor of Arts (BA) and a Bachelor of Science (BS) degree program. Detailed below are the minimum requirements for all students that have declared their major in fall 2021 or later. For students who declared prior to fall 2021, see the department's website for requirements.

All history majors must complete 2 years of a second language regardless of the degree choice. They must demonstrate language proficiency either by completing (with a C-/P or better) at least the 3rd term of a 2nd year of another language or by examination, showing competence equivalent to that attained at the end of 2 years of college study.

History courses that satisfy major requirements must be taken for letter grades. 21 upper-division credits, including 3 courses numbered 410–499, and all courses taken to fulfill the HIST 407 research paper requirement must be taken at the University of Oregon. Specific requirements follow:

49 Minimum Graded Credits In History

Up to 16 lower-division credits, which includes HIST 290. At least 33 credits must be from upper-division courses, which include at least 21 credits at the 400-level. No more than 8 graded credits of HIST 405 (Reading and Conference) may be used to fulfill major requirements.

Hist 290 Historian's Craft

This is the only required lower-division course, and it is included in the 16 lower-division credits. It should be taken early in the major, but it is not intended for first-years.

8 Upper-Division Credits In Pre-1800 History, which may also count towards field requirement below.

HIST 407 Seminar Research Paper

In exceptional circumstances, with written approval, a term paper written in a colloquium (HIST 408) or in a 400-level lecture course may be expanded into a research paper. Contact history department advisors for approval.

Grade Point Average (GPA) Of 2.5 Or Higher in history courses taken at the University of Oregon. A mid-C grade or better is required in courses taken to fulfill the research paper requirement.
